<b>Why?</b>	<p>At the Kimberley Renal Services strategic planning meetings in 2015 it was identified that many of our resources needed review. We have started a process of review which involves consultation with regional stakeholders, piloting initial drafts with consumer groups, and sticking to a consistent style guide.</p> <p>We hope to produce resources that are simple and effective, allow us to communicate effectively with our clients and result in improved health outcomes.</p>
<b>Who? When? Where?</b>	<p>Our first panel of resources is intending to assist providers to discuss test results with patients. We have trialled our process with the development of our first resource, "Diabetes Check". Our next two will be "Kidney Check" and "Blood Pressure Check".</p>
<b>How are you making it happen?</b>	<p>We are currently making this happen through integration with our regional outreach visits through the East and West Kimberley. Other organisations such as Boab Health, as well as primary care providers across the region, have helped us in the pilot and redrafting processes.</p>
<b>So...</b>	<p>Feedback from the development of the first resource has been positive so far. We now need to keep our momentum up so we can work on finishing our next resource.</p>
<b>How do you plan to get feedback?</b>	<p>After developing our other two resources, we would like to see if using these resources helps people to manage their risk of chronic diseases.</p>
